Santa Clarita on Location

Have you noticed Santa Clarita on TV lately? Whatever the script may call for in order to create the perfect location....Santa Clarita delivers. Our City has stood in for Virginia on "NCIS," Utah on "Big Love," Colorado on "Make It or Break It" and even Scranton, Pennsylvania for an episode or two of "The Office." Santa Clarita is also home to two new highly acclaimed shows including "Justified," which helms from Kentucky and "Sons of Tucson," which obviously takes place in....well....Tucson.



Film Incentive Program (FIP)

The City of Santa Clarita continues to reward productions that base and frequently film on location in Santa Clarita through the City's Film Incentive Program (FIP). Three more productions have earned the financial benefits of the program, Fox's "Sons of Tucson," HBO's "Big Love," and Faster, a feature film starring Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson.

"Sons of Tucson" received a full refund of paid permit fees through the FIP's first incentive option that focuses on locally based productions. The show was based at Santa Clarita Studios, with 88% of principal photography taking place at locations in the Santa Clarita area (including businesses and homes), and 20% of the cast and crew were local Santa Clarita residents. The new show premiered recently on Fox. HBO's "Big Love" received a partial refund of paid permit fees through the second incentive option which focuses on recurring productions. The show has based in Santa Clarita at Avenue Scott Stages since its inception and regularly films on location around town. The fourth season of "Big Love" just wrapped on HBO and the show has been picked up for a fifth season. The feature film Faster, which wrapped filming on Soledad Canyon in Santa Clarita this past week, received partial subsidization of permit fees through the City's incentive program and is one of the films that qualified for California's production incentives.

Santa Clarita is the first city in the Los Angeles area to implement film incentives and create a program in conjunction with the State's. To date, eight productions that qualified for California's incentives have filmed on location in Santa Clarita, including FX's new television show "Justified," which is based at Santa Clarita Studios, and Priest, a vampire feature that transformed Melody Ranch Motion Picture Studios into a post-apocalyptic western town.

Disney/ABC Studios announced plan for Disney/ABC Studios at The Ranch, a new Los Angeles County based studio project bringing a dozen soundstages and new production facilities to Disney's Golden Oak Ranch. The project will create thousands of new jobs, energizing business throughout Los Angeles County and the Santa Clarita Valley. The project is expected to generate \$522 million in direct economic activity throughout LA County during construction and \$533 in annual economic activity throughout LA County at full build out.
