

Santa Clarita Film Permit Fees (effective July 1, 2019):

- Motion Picture Permit - \$385
- Movie Ranch Motion Picture Permit - \$154
(Blue Cloud Movie Ranch, Rancho Deluxe, Rancho Maria, Rene's 50's Town, Sable Ranch, Veluzat Motion Picture Ranch only)
- Still Photo Permit - \$120
- Bus Stop Closure - \$200/occurrence/day
- Expedited Signature Survey - \$217/occurrence
- Monitor - \$76/hour
- Notification - \$134/location (minor/regular set) & \$277/location (large set/mailer)
- Rider (minor revisions) - \$70
- Right of Way Use (No ITC) - \$216/occurrence/day
- Road Use - Closure (lane or road) - \$699/occurrence/day/location
- Road Use - ITC/Driving Shots - \$216/occurrence/day
- Road Use - Parking - \$315/occurrence/day
- City-owned Property Use (parks, pools, open space, etc.) – prices vary, contact Film Office for specific rates
- Other fees or staff as required (sign removal, etc.) – prices vary, contact Film Office for quote

Los Angeles County Fire Department Film Permit Fees (effective January 1, 2011):

- Film Permit - \$282.00
- Fuel Dispensing Trucks & Vehicles - \$223.00
- Pyrotechnics & Special Effects - \$288.00
- Commercial Still Photography - \$277.00 (on site cast and crew numbers, 16+ persons)

L.A. County Sheriff Rates (effective July 1, 2019):

The following are the City of Santa Clarita's contracted hourly rates for L.A. County Sheriffs which offer a significant savings to production (\$7 to \$21 per hour) when compared to the private party/standard rates. All rates are per hour and do not include mileage.

- Deputy, Generalist - \$88.69/hr.
- Deputy, Bonus I - \$96.56/hr.
- Deputy, Bonus II - \$116.45/hr.
- Sergeant - \$105.36/hr.
- Lieutenant - \$126.66/hr.
